
ELF Kitchen Kits – Door styles

Plain doors

The doors are supplied in light wood, but can be finished in the following ways

- Painted (see white kitchen below)
- High gloss finish – (see kitchen in gloss black below)
- Laminate effect – vary according to availability. (see blue leather grain combined with light wood below) Use Fablon or other self-adhesive plastic film (instructions given for using this)
- Stainless steel (see black or white kitchens below, where steel is combined with another finish)
- For glass-fronted units to combine with plain doors, see Shaker doors.

Shaker panelled doors and glass fronted doors – options

Supplied in lightwood, these can be finished as follows.

- Left in light wood and then hand-waxed
- Painted in the colour of your choice
- Light wood with painted centre panel (see below right).
- Co-ordinating glass-fronted cabinet (these can be combined with plain doors also). Note: these frames can be used with plain or opaque glass and are suitable for combining with any other door style.



ELF Kitchen Kits - Door styles

Classic (with or without raised centre panel)

Supplied in lightwood, these doors can be finishes as follows

- Left in lightwood and hand-waxed for a fine finish
- Painted in the colour of your choice.
- Painted with contrast mouldings
- For glass-fronted doors, use the standard glass-fronted units and add mouldings.
