## ELF Compact Kitchen Kit

### The kit comes with:

- The unit kit plus...
- Hob for the cooker
- Metal sink
- Drawer handles
- Door knobs

### You will need to provide:

- Sandpaper
- Craft knife
- Small drill
- PVA Wood glue
- Right angle gluing jig or Lego
- Elastic bands
- Paint & paint brush
- Contact adhesive

**W**ith this kit you can make a state-of-the-art kitchen for a modern dolls house, or just to bring your older house right up to date. The kit comes with a choice of colours both for the work surface and the cupboard doors; I have chosen bright red for mine, but the range includes a good selection of different colours and finishes.

The kit can be constructed with the sink unit on the left or right, so it is also versatile and will adjust to the shape of your dolls house room and position of your doors and windows.

I am often a little daunted by the amount of component parts

when I open up some kits! In the case of this kitchen, the instructions couldn't be clearer, and it really doesn't take a rocket scientist to put this together successfully and neatly to make a fabulous piece for the dolls house. In total, from opening the packets to the final result you see photographed here, it has taken me about four hours to complete the kit. That doesn't include the periods in between whilst I waited for paint and glue to dry.

The quality of the accessories is excellent and beautifully to scale. The wooden pieces are accurately cut and require no extra trimming or adjustments. The only slightly tricky bit was cutting out the sink

recess from the worktop, but this doesn't have to be too perfect as the metal sink and granite film of the work surface cover the cutting lines anyway.

I have no hesitation in recommending this kit, and others from the ELF collection, to everyone. Please take a peek at their website for a full selection of the modern dolls house items available in their range.
